

### Multimodal Presentation (created by Prof. Shifflett)

Slide	Information
Title Slide	Include a creative presentation title and presenter information.
Introduction	Must contain your thesis/argument and a potential solution.
Background	Should cover the major ideas of your research (think <i>literature review</i> ). What does your audience need to know in order to understand your argument?
Your Argument	Why should we consider your perspective on the issue? What reasoning and evidence can you point to in order to support your argument?
Objections/Responses	Consider the multiple perspectives on your issue. What are their objections to your argument and what is your response?
Conclusion	Restate your thesis with any insights based on your presentation of the material. What do you want to leave the audience thinking about?
Reference	Include citations of ALL of your sources, in alphabetical order.



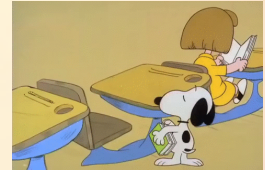

### BASIC Outline of Information Needed

Slide	Information
Title Slide	Include a creative presentation title and presenter information.
Overall Introduction	Introduce us to what we will be hearing today.
What is Your Claim?	Ex. Capital Punishment is immoral.
Define Your Evaluative Term	Ex. Immoral – <i>You would discuss what an immoral act is, because that could mean different things to different people; This lays the ground work for why you see capital punishment as immoral.</i>
Gain Your Audience's Agreement	Ex. Show us why capital punishment is immoral – <i>Test your evaluation through Syllogism.</i>
Conclusion	Restate your thesis with any insights based on your presentation of the material. What do you want to leave the audience thinking about?
References	Include citations of ALL of your sources, in alphabetical order.
